Tiger Leaping Gorge

It is very mountainous with peaks as high as 5,000 metres. Yunnan is home to Tiger Leaping Gorge, a scenic canyon on the Jinsha River which is a primary tributary of the Yangtze River. It is located 60 kilometres north of Lijiang, Other places to see are Dali and Shangri-la.

The Chinese have built a new Motorway from Kunming to Dali and almost onto Shangri-la which means the old road is great for those not in a hurry and who want to see the real Yunnan.
